



RELEASE NOTES SCRIPTSURE CLOUD E-PRESCRIBING (ERX) – DAW SYSTEMS, INC.

ScriptSure Cloud ERX program update is set for release May 15, 2020 during off-peak hours (10pm EST). This update is referred to as Version 2.0 Release 2020.5. This document details per screen and per section updates that Users will see and encounter.

PRIMARY CHANGE SUMMARY

The following is an overview of the largest functional and visual changes and additions that Users will encounter and should be aware of:

1. Simplified ability to approve multiple medications and prescription detail window.
2. DENY ALL IN QUEUE functionality updated to allow single click to DENY ALL. Added confirmation window with explanation of impact before clicking.
3. Removed duplicate medications when searching from PRESCRIBE NEW DRUG button as well as the CHART SEARCH FOR NEW MEDICATION search box.
4. Removed Max Daily Dose field from prescription preview screen – Surescripts network deemed this a non-required field. Removed from on-screen display and entry.
5. If a medication is searched for and is in-active (no longer has current doses) ScriptSure will suggest alternatives such as brand vs generic and vice-versa (e.g. Search for Lurasidone, which no longer has active doses, ScriptSure will suggest Possible alternative Medication of Latuda, which is the BRAND name for the drug and does have current and active doses that can be ordered.
6. Allowed for change of dose when after having selected the dose and arrived at prescription preview window.
7. Changed the Prescription detail window to minimal design and if there are multiple prescriptions to approve, changed to design that allows all to be seen more easily (with detailed view still available).

ISSUES RESOLVED

BUG FIXES AND REPORT FIXES

1. Repaired user reported random selection of Current Prescriber between patients.
2. Alphabetize Medications in order sets.
3. Repaired sending of Order Sets after creation.
4. Increased length of Drug Description.
5. Repaired PMP Interface connection for institutional connections.

MEDICATION AND PHARMACY LISTS

1. Updated Pharmacy Lists.

2. Updates formulary download lists.
3. Added function to confirm up-to-date National Drug Code (NDC) and RxNORM values are available for selected medications:
 - a. If no NDC or RxNORM available, the application will suggest alternatives that can be prescribed and stop the user from prescribing the medication that does not have the NDC or RxNORM value.


SCREEN CHANGES DETAIL

CHART SCREEN

1. Chart Navigation (left side of screen) - Removed Dashboard Tab and moved the Prescriptions tab to top.
2. Modified Last Prescription and Last Current Prescription Views to only show unique medications and the number of instances med has been prescribed.

PRESCRIPTION PREVIEW SCREEN

1. Added ability to SELECT A DIFFERENT DOSE from the Prescription Preview screen.
2. Moved Save Only and Print buttons to top of Screen.
3. Moved Cancel button to the left.
4. Changed button and field labels:
 - a. Qualifier to **FORM**
 - b. CONFIGURE SIG to **OPTIONS**
 - c. FREE FORM to **CHANGE TO FREE FORM**
 - d. CHRONIC to **No Expiration Date**
 - e. New Pharmacy to **CHANGE PHARMACY**
 - f. Delivery to **ACTION**

PHARMACY SELECTION SCREEN

1. Expanded the Pharmacy search fields to include at top of screen to include:
 - a. Street Address
 - b. Phone
2. Expanded the length of the Pharmacy Name field
3. Removed auto-population of City and State when searching by Zip code.
4. Changed orientation of Patient Preferred from vertical to horizontal.
5. Moved Frequently Used Pharmacies (COMMON) to right hand side of the page
6. Changed the search results for a pharmacy to show in a GRID and select button moved to the left

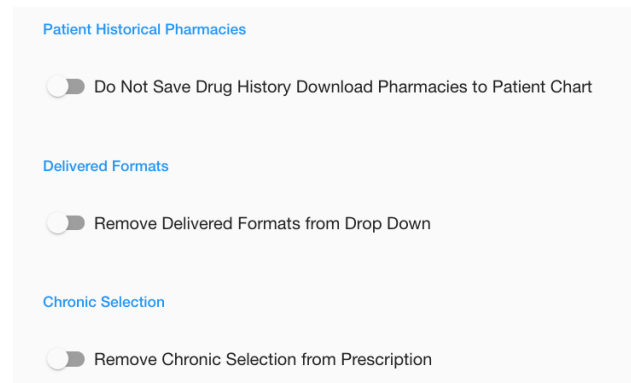

SETUP AND GENERAL CHANGES

1. Added Practice Settings (these can be found in: SETTINGS>PRACTICE SETTING>ADVANCED PRACTICE SETTINGS)
 - a. Added setting to prevent the application from automatically saving downloaded pharmacies to the patient preferred pharmacy list.
 - b. Added setting to remove the delivered formats from the medications (users must create their own formats for the medications in terms of number and directions (SIG) that will be on the medications orders.
 - c. Added setting to remove the CHRONIC Selection (renamed from Chronic to “No Expiration Date” on the prescription preview window.
